Introduction to LTB

- ➤ The Luxembourg Testing Board has started its activities in January 2009 and was created by participants from CRP Henri Tudor, UBS, CTG and Eureka-ITS.
- ➤ Its goal is to:
 - ➤ Develop a network dedicated to testing and quality and promote the evolution and enhancements of these topics in the field of IT;
 - ➤ Define and promote standardized content for software testing trainings in Luxembourg according the international "ISTQB Certified Tester" qualification scheme.
- ➤ LTB is member of ISTQB



Develop a Network dedicated to testing

- ➤ Events organized every 3 or 4 months in the evening. Each event has a particular topic chosen by members;
- ➤ A private "shared point" on the web where members have the possibility to exchange ideas about a particular subject;
- ➤ User groups on particular subjects, defined by members (year 2010).



Promote the ISTQB qualification scheme

- ➤ The ISTQB is responsible for the international qualification scheme called "ISTQB Certified Tester". The qualifications are based on a syllabus.
- ➤ An examination exists for different levels. After the examination, each successful participant receives the "ISTQB Certified Tester" certificate for the specific level.
- ➤ Advantage of the Certification : To have a common knowledge and to be able to evaluate your real level.

B Luxembourg Advantages for members

- ➤ Participation in LTB events and user groups;
- ➤ Participation in choosing and presenting the themes of those events and user groups;
- ➤ Access to a restricted "shared point" on the web to share important information with other members of the board;
- ➤ Reduction of 10% for each ISTQB exam;
- ➤ Possibility to ask questions and give advises to the ISTQB worldwide community.

Networking (1)

- ➤ Create a Networking around Testing
 - ➤ Share experiences and Knowledge
 - ➤ No commercial or financial purpose
 - ➤ Ethic view (forget corporate reflex, ...)
 - ➤ Open on the other community (Java, Open source, ...)
 - ➤ Work together on a specific area or domain
- ➤ LTB will play the role of « facilitator ». It means that we will not enforce at any level, but we will help people to meet and give some guidelines when it is necessary.

Proposal: E = Event S = Subject definition (15 days) WD = Working group definition (15 days). WG = Working group (around 2 months): The group will work on the selected subject and prepare a small presentation to summarize its work F = Finalization of the preparation E = Event: One or several persons of the working group will present their work and enter into a discussion with the other participants. LTB will play the role of facilitator and will animate the working group Of course, we are open to any suggestion and it is one of the objectives of this kick-off.
